A third generation member of a business family, Diana facilitates family retreats and multi-generational conversations about wealth. She speaks directly about her relationship with money and she invites others to do the same. A dynamic educator, Diana has extensive experience mentoring inheritors (with a special sensitivity to the issues facing women of wealth) and focuses on preparing them both to take responsibility for their inheritance and grow in their ability to be financially self-sustaining.
